



## EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS

**Dear Parent,**

Lee A. Tolbert Community Academy is dedicated to keeping you informed about your student's education. According to the **Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (Public Law 114-95)** you have the right to know the following regarding your child's education:

- 1) Whether your student's teacher has met State qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- 2) Whether your student's teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived,
- 3) Whether your student's teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of their certification,
- 4) Whether your child is provided services by a paraprofessional and, if so, their qualifications.

In addition to the information that parents may request, any building receiving Title 1.A. funds must provide to each individual parent:

- Information on the level of achievement and academic growth of your student, if applicable and available, on each of the State academic assessments required under Title 1.A.
- Timely notice that your student has been assigned or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who has not met applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.
